Use the Zoom app on a computer / tablet / smart phone, or use a traditional phone to dial and hear the meeting:

- At ~6:15 pm, either open Zoom app on your computer / tablet / smart phone, and click "**Join,**" or use your traditional (i.e., not a "smart") phone to dial one of numbers listed at the bottom of the next page.
- When prompted, enter "Meeting ID 899 8256 7478, then enter "Password" 236091.

- 2. Join early: we have inspirational videos starting at 6:15.
- 3. When joining the meeting, the host will connect you on "mute," i.e., others will not hear you. Use the Zoom "chat" button to enter and send a text message.

Joining and Viewing Our Zoom Meetings

- 1. Please view or review videos at the above link, and complete these steps before starting to join our meeting:
 - a. New to Zoom: Download and install the Zoom Application (App)
 - b. Returning to Zoom: Check for App updates
 - c. All: Check your video and audio
- 2. Go to "Applications," if Zoom app icon is not on your desktop or dock.



- 3. Click Zoom icon to open, then click "Join" or "Join a Meeting."
 - a. On a tablet / smart phone: when prompted, enter the meeting ID and password. If this is your first meeting, allow Zoom to access your microphone & camera.
 - b. <u>On Computer</u>: Enter meeting ID, press "Join," then password and "Join." Always retest your computer audio before joining the meeting. If there are problems, review how to test and adjust audio. (See instructions in above link).
 - c. If you connect, but inadvertently leave the meeting, repeat step 3.a or 3.b. If you can't connect or reconnect, text **520-981-8800**.
- 4. <u>Participating</u>; In large meetings, the host mutes all but the presenter, so you can hear but can't be heard. Don't "un-mute" yourself. Communicate using "chat" to text or click "Participants" to "raise hand" to request the that the host un-mute you.
- 5. Adjust Your Screen. Zoom allows you to change your display. We recommend:
 - a. View the speaker only rather than all participants: In the upper right corner of display, click on either (1) "Speaker View." or (2) the single box.





- b. At top of display, click on "View Options." In dialog box, look at "Side by Side." It should be checked for the teaching, to see both the presenter and the slides. For Adoration, it should be unchecked, to focus on Eucharist.
- c. When "side by side" is <u>not</u> checked, either the presenter or the slide fills most of the screen. Click on the "box in a box" icon in the upper right corner to reverse which is larger.

Can't Join Using Zoom? Use a Traditional Phone to Hear Meeting

Dial any one of these numbers: (346) 248 7799, (669) 900 9128, (253) 215 8782, (312) 626 6799, (646) 558 8656, or (301) 715 8592. (Note – these are not toll-free)

When prompted, enter meeting ID & password from front page.. You will be on "mute," i.e., you will hear but not be heard. To toggle the mute on/off, press "*7" ("Star – 7").

In a large meeting, please don't interject comments unless asked; instead

Press "*9" ("Star – 9") to "raise your hand" for a comment or question
