Fr. Ken will provide background on Charles Dickens, discuss important themes in the work and answer initial questions. Session will conclude with an abbreviated reading from Stave One - Marley's Ghost with the help of parishioner, Thomas Fleming as the voice and persona of Ebenezer Scrooge.

As literary commentator Joseph Pearce says: "The lesson that **A Christmas Carol** teaches is that our lives are not owned by us but are owed to another to whom the debt must be paid in the currency of self-sacrifice, which is love's means of exchange."
